Excellency,

I have the honour to write to you in my capacity as Coordinator of the United Nations Panel of Experts on Libya, established pursuant to Security Council resolution 1973 (2011) and most recently extended by resolution 2213 (2015).

As your Excellency is aware, the Panel has been mandated by Security Council resolutions 2144 (2014) and 2146 (2014) to assist the Security Council's Libya Sanctions Committee in carrying out its mandate and to gather, examine and analyse information from States, relevant United Nations bodies, regional organisations and other interested parties regarding the implementation of the measures decided in resolutions 1970 (2011), 1973 (2011), 2009 (2011), 2040 (2012), 2095 (2013), 2144 (2014), 2146 (2014), 2174 (2014) and 2213 (2015), including the arms embargo.

The Panel would like to thank the Serbian authorities for their support and for the information they have previously provided.

The Panel has received information regarding an end-user certificate (EUC) signed by Mr. Khaled Sherif in December 2014 for RPG launchers and ammunition for small, light and heavy systems (see Annex). The document notes that the materiel will be exported by a company based in Serbia: *Tehnoremont*, Temerin.

It is against this background that the Panel would like to obtain additional information including the following ones:

- Has any contract been signed in relation to this EUC by *Tehnoremont*? If so, the Panel would like to obtain a copy of the document.
- Has any of the materiel mentioned on the EUC been transferred to Libya yet? If this is the case, the Panel would like to obtain information about the types and quantities of materiel delivered, methods of transportation, dates and locations of delivery and precise identity of the recipient(s) of the materiel, and be provided with copies of bills of lading, cargo manifests or air waybills, and copies of packing lists and customs declarations.


